“Christmas as a season may seem to be a lost cause. What energy could possibly be left after the pre-Christmas season? Yet there is still enough festivity called forth by the telling of the story of this birth to carry us through New Year and to Epiphany. We compete with the world already when we decide to wait through Advent, when we say that you can’t hear the story in all its awesomeness, you can’t sing the Christmas songs and wear the Christmas colours and make a festival of it – unless you wait. Once that is done, extending the festival through the season is easy.”

Liturgy with Style and Grace (Huck; Chinchar – Liturgy Training Publication)

There is a wealth of hymns, songs and acclamations from which to choose for this most joyous of liturgies. The following points may help in deciding your selection:

Consider your Parish and congregation. Remember that Christmas is often a time when families are together. It is likely that you will share your Christmas liturgy with people who neither come regularly to Mass, nor attend your liturgies at any other time of the year. How welcome and included will your visitors feel?

Christmas is for the whole community, not just for children...remember the Gospel narratives in Luke and Matthew: apart from the baby Jesus, and with the exception of Mary, all other characters in the story would be considered elderly.

Prepare the liturgy with the other ministries within your Parish: Priests, Deacons, Servers, Readers, Eucharistic Ministers, Flower Arrangers, etc... This often gives the various groups a greater sense of community and purpose. The better prepared you are, the greater the celebration.
